

# Caring for Your Magnetic Signs

1. Be sure both the vehicle and the backs of the signs are clean and free from debris.
  - \* Waxing of the vehicle and the front of the signs is fine.
2. Be certain that there is steel to adhere to.
  - \* Many times vehicles are damaged and repaired with body filler which inhibits the magnetic signs from sticking. Magnetic signs will also not stick to aluminum, stainless, galvanized, wood, carboard, plastics or fiberglass.
3. Place the signs on a smooth area on the vehicle. Never over door gaps, body moldings or sharp angles.
  - \* If wind is allowed behind the signs, they will fly off.
4. Magnetic signs must be removed regularly to clean behind and around the edges of the signs.
  - \* This is a good time to inspect the signs for damage.
5. When removed or not in use, always place the signs on a flat steel surface such as a refrigerator or file cabinet to insure they keep their flat shape.
  - \* If stored improperly, the magnetic signs will misshapen or warp allowing wind behind the signs.
